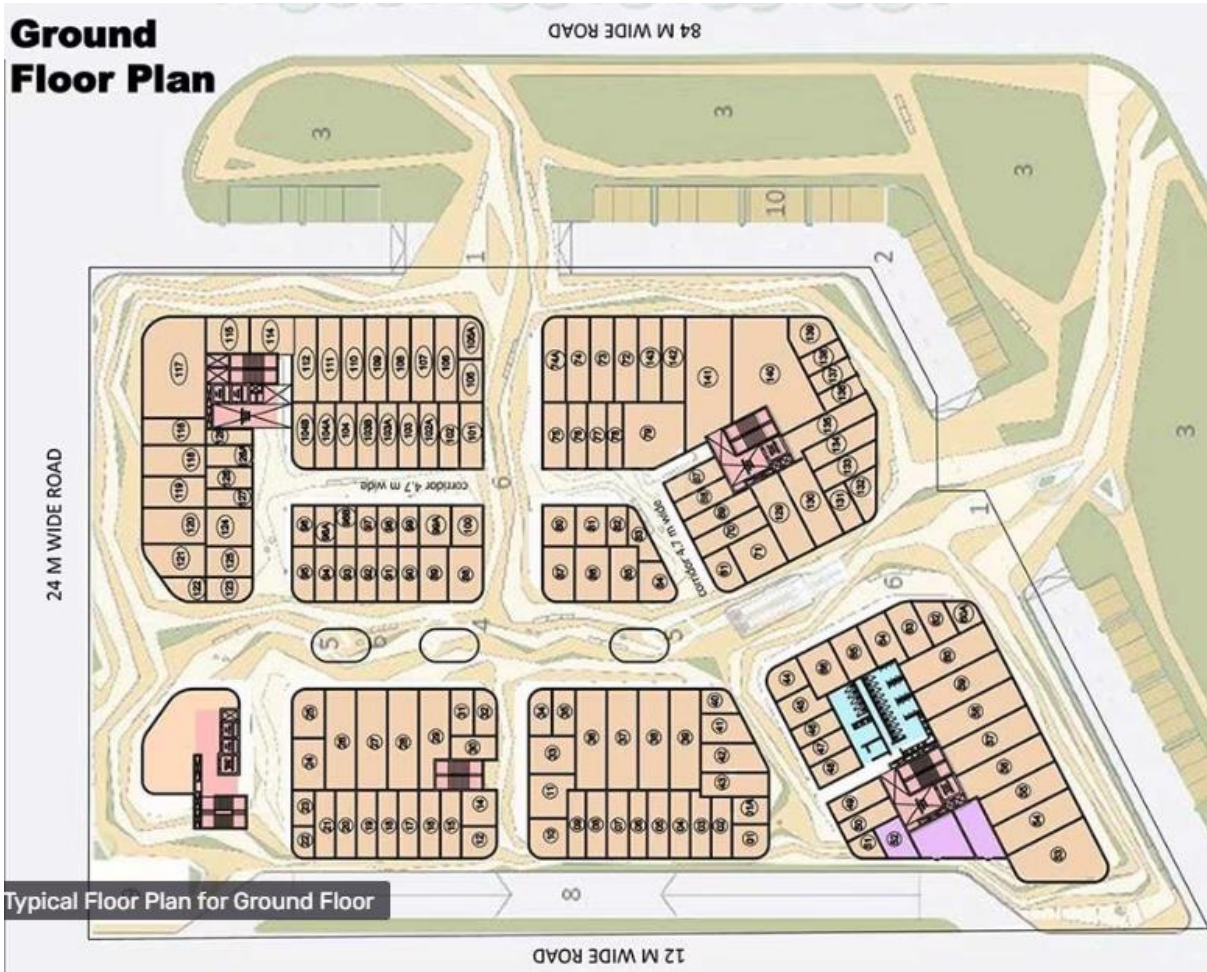


Floor Plans



FIRST FLOOR PLAN

Service Areas and Features:

- Conference Room:** Located in the top left section.
- Reception:** Located in the top right section.
- Storage:** Located in the bottom left section.
- Restroom:** Located in the bottom middle section.
- Corridor:** A central corridor system connecting the various sections.
